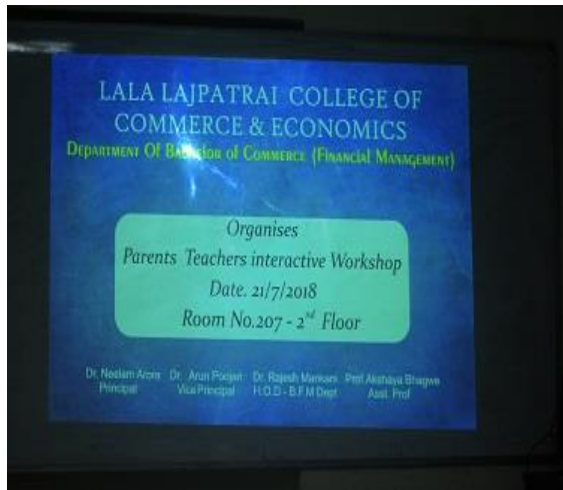

BRIEF REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY

BFM Department students collaborated with The Plane Jar, a well-known NGO & Dr. Harish Iyer a well known psychologist, who work with people facing psychological issues and provide appropriate solutions through psychological counselling and rehabilitation of the affected persons.



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The collaborating partner had brought a number of speakers on the subject who through narrating of own personal experiences, brought to the fore the burning issue of body shaming which is often ignored or not given serious consideration. Ms. Taniya who was one of the speakers, shared her personal psychological traumatic experiences with the audience and showed them how people can get mentally scarred.

The collaborating partner and the BFM Department students drove home the point of recognizing the hidden evils of body shaming and how it can be tackled.

OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAM

1. The student participants came back with greater understanding about the mental health issues which are so common among the student community
2. The students learnt about several issues which are the root cause of the mental health issues but are often ignored
3. The students gained empathy for people undergoing such issues and also got to learn from the experiences shared by the resource person and the others from the NGO
